UPU 54th INTERNATIONAL LETTER WRITING COMPETITION FOR YOUNG PEOPLE AGED 15 YEARS AND BELOW- 2025

The Postal Corporation of Kenya (PCK) in liaison with Universal Postal Union- International Bureau, is proud to announce the topic for the 2025 International Letter Writing Competition for Young People aged 15 years and below.

The competition rules are as follows:

The competition rules and regulations are as follows:

1. The composition **MUST** be presented in the form of a letter.
2. The composition **MUST** include the first and surname, date of birth as well as gender of the participant.
3. The composition should not exceed 1000 words.
4. The participant should indicate either private or school address for ease of communication. The telephone number of the school and parents/guardians should be included.
5. Parents/Guardians and Teachers should NOT assist in the composition writing.
6. The composition must be submitted to the address below **on or before Friday 11th April 2025 close of business.**
7. All compositions **MUST** be posted to the address given . Appropriate postage stamps should be affixed on each envelope. All entries that will not have been delivered via the Post Office will automatically be disqualified.
8. **Only one entry will be allowed in each envelope posted.**

The topic of the composition is:

'Imagine you are an ocean. Write a letter to someone explaining why and how they should take good care of you'
